

Setting up your Vehicle Checklist



This checklist is to ensure your have properly set your vehicle up before you pick up your new caravan. Using this checklist will ensure your focus is on your new van when you go through the handover, rather than questioning your vehicle set-up.

Towing_ Mirrors	Installed, or have a pair with me to install during the handover? (Have the mirrors been tested to ensure they fit)	Yes / No
Tyre pressures	My tyre pressures are correct for towing? (Ensure you have researched your tyre type to check the correct tyre pressures. If you are still unsure find an expert who can help).	Yes / No
Suspension	The suspension on my vehicle is suitable to handle the extra tow ball load from my new Van? (If unsure, speak to an expert for advice).	Yes / No
<u>Hitch</u>	My hitch is correct for my new van?	Yes / No

This is to ensure you are within you manufacturer weight limits for your vehicle. Please enter in your vehicle and Van weights below. Ask the manufacturer or person selling the van to send you the Van weights information you need.

Now with this information head over to www.jimmygcaravanpro.com/beforeyoubuyweightscalculator
& use this calculator to see if you are within your Vehicle & Trailer weight limits. This calculator does not show vehicle axle weights. This is because you haven't picked up or purchased your new van as yet, therefore there is no caravan to connect to your vehicle to produce an accurate reading for us to use axle weights. This calculator will add the proposed 'tow ball weight' of your new van to your vehicle GVM.
